

DRIVER EDUCATION

The Board of Education, recognizing its share of responsibility in promoting road safety for everyone in the district, offers driver education as an elective to eligible students.

In accordance with state law, driver education courses will be offered on a noncredit basis and, therefore, will not count towards a student's graduation requirements.

All students who take the course will have the permission of their parents, and will possess a provisional license in accordance with state law.

Since the Board further believes that the fundamental purpose of a driver education program is to produce responsible, safe drivers, not merely students who will be able to secure licenses, students who already have a driver's license will be eligible for the program on the same basis as those without a license.
